



A GOOD STARTING HOLE REQUIRING A TEE SHOT DOWN THE LEFT CENTER OF THE FAIRWAY. FROM THERE THE APPROACH IS TO A LARGE GREEN WHICH SLOPES FROM FRONT TO BACK.

2 A STRONG PAR 3 FROM THE ELEVATED TEE OVER THE MARSH. CLUB SELECTION IS A MUST ON THIS CHALLENGING TEE SHOT.



A DOGLEG LEFT PAR 5 WHICH CAN BE REACHED IN TWO. HOWEVER, YOU WANT TO AVOID THE SMALL POND JUST SHORT AND LEFT OF THE GREEN ON YOUR APPROACH.

4 A GOOD STRAIGHT DRIVING HOLE WITH A CONTOURED FAIRWAY WHICH HELPS KEEP THE BALL IN THE SHORT GRASS. BE CAREFUL NOT TO GO LONG ON YOUR SECOND SHOT.



A GORGEOUS DOGLEG LEFT OVER THE WETLANDS. THE SECOND SHOT MUST CARRY THE WATER HAZARD PROTECTING THE GREEN. ONE OF THE BEST HOLES ON THE COURSE.

6 A SHORT PAR 3 WITH BUNKERING IN FRONT OF THE TEE. PLAY YOUR TEE SHOT OVER THE EVERGREEN TO A DEEP GREEN PROTECTED BY MARSH ON THE RIGHT AND O.B. ON THE LEFT.



A TOUGH PAR 5 THAT REQUIRES PRECISION OFF THE TEE. CUTTING CORNER OFF TEE IS NOT AN OPTION SINCE IT IS 300 YARDS TO CARRY.

8 A GOOD UPHILL PAR 4 TO AN ELEVATED GREEN THAT HAS WATER LURKING BEHIND IT AND TO THE RIGHT. PLACE YOUR TEE SHOT DOWN THE LEFT CENTER OF THE FAIRWAY TO AVOID THE LARGE WASTE BUNKER.



PLACE YOUR TEE SHOT DOWN THE RIGHT CENTER OF THE FAIRWAY ON THIS SHARP DOGLEG LEFT. THIS WILL PROVIDE THE BEST APPROACH TO THE UPHILL GREEN.

THIS MEDIUM DISTANCE PAR 4 FAVORS A TEE SHOT DOWN THE RIGHT SIDE OF THE FAIRWAY. THE SECOND SHOT IS DOWNHILL, SO BE CAREFUL NOT TO GO LONG. TROUBLE AWAITS.

11 A PAR 3 OVER WATER TO A TRICKY GREEN WHICH SLOPES SIGNIFICANTLY FROM BACK TO FRONT. PLAY YOUR TEE SHOT TOWARDS THE RIGHT CENTER OF THE GREEN FOR BEST RESULTS.



THIS LONG PAR 5 REQUIRES AN ACCURATE SECOND SHOT BETWEEN TWO LAKES. THE APPROACH IS NO BARGAIN TO A GREEN SURROUNDED BY WATER ON THREE SIDES.

13 A TEE SHOT THAT FAVORS THE LEFT CENTER OF THE FAIRWAY LEAVES YOU A SECOND SHOT TO AN ELEVATED GREEN. HOLE PLAYS LONGER THAN IT LOOKS.



ACCURACY OFF THE TEE IS VERY IMPORTANT ON THIS PAR 4. A GOOD DRIVE WILL LEAVE YOU A SHORT UPHILL SECOND SHOT.

15 A TRICKY PAR 3 WITH WATER RIGHT OF GREEN. PLAY YOUR TEE SHOT TO THE FRONT THIRD OF THE GREEN FOR BEST RESULTS.



DOUBLE DOGLEG WHICH IS ONE OF THE MOST SCENIC AND THOUGHT PROVOKING HOLES ON THE COURSE. AIM AT THE BULLSEYE OFF THE TEE AS WELL AS THE 175 YARD LAY UP TO LANDING AREA.

17 A STRONG PAR 3 FROM THE ELEVATED TEE OVER THE WETLAND. PLAY TEE SHOT TO THE FRONT THIRD OF GREEN. BE CAREFUL NOT TO GO LONG...TROUBLE AWAITS.



BEAUTIFUL UPHILL DOGLEG LEFT REQUIRING AN ACCURATE DRIVE. A GOOD DRIVE WILL LEAVE YOU WITH A SHORT IRON TO AN ELEVATED GREEN.
